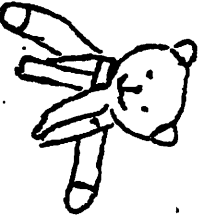


# Teddies for Tragedies

Small Bear



## Knitting Instructions - smaller size bear

**MATERIALS:** Oddments of double knitting in four colours. Main colour is head & paws; Jumper colour, trouser colour, scarf colour. Needles size 10. safe washable filling material. (Please do not use foam as this is dangerous to young children)

**N.B.** The teddy is in garter stitch except for the head which is in stocking stitch.

Cast on 6 sts main colour for paws. Knit 6 rows. Change to trouser colour & knit 16 rows. Slip these 6 stitches onto a holder. Make another leg the same.

Knit across all 12 sts and knit 10 rows. Change to jumper colour and knit 16 rows.

Change to main colour for head and change to stocking stitch (one row knit, one row purl). Work for .....ins (28 rows) & change to jumper colour. Continue remainder of teddy in reverse order and cast off.

Make arms by ~~fasting~~ teddy in half widthways at head, with right sides together, sew seam on either side of head.

With right sides facing, with jumper colour pick up 5 sts either side of neck join and knit 12 rows. Change to main colour and knit 6 rows for paw. Cast off.

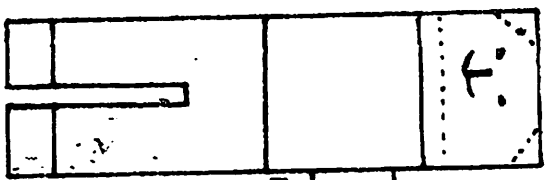
**Scarf.** Cast on 40 sts. knit 2 rows. Cast off.

Sew up teddy, right sides together, leaving an opening at crotch. Turn teddy right way out & sew diagonally across top of corners of head to make ears. Stuff teddy & sew up remaining opening. Run a thread around the neck, draw up to shape the head and neck. Fasten securely. Sew a happy face on teddy. Do not use buttons or plastic eyes for safety reasons. Attach scarf securely at back of neck so that it is free to tie & untie.

Fabric bags with draw strings ~~measuring~~ approx. 13" x 10" would be greatly appreciated as each teddy is dispatched in it's own bag, so adding to the play value

Stears with Huska
